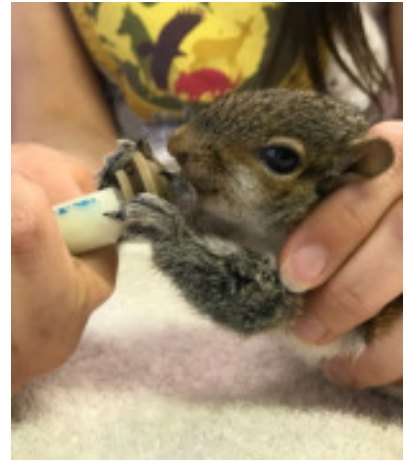




# AWARE Animal Caregiver



- What: Caring for AWARE's injured and orphaned rehab patients.
- Duties: Feeding, medicating, cleaning enclosures, laundry, dishes, sweeping, mopping.
- When: Dedicated weekly shift 10:30a-2:30p, 2p-6p, or 6p-close
- Attendance: Must make scheduled shifts or make up w/in 30 days
- Must wear: Closed-toed shoes, long pants
- Should wear: Waterproof shoes that you don't wear for anything else, long-sleeve shirt
- Must not wear: Facial piercings, dangling jewelry, red clothes, inappropriate words or images
- Vaccinations: Must be vaccinated for tetanus & covid; pets must be current; must have rabies vaccine to work w/ RVS species
- Where: AWARE Center, 4158 Klondike Road, Stonecrest, GA 30038
- Age: 18 and up. 16- and 17- year-olds sometimes accepted on trial basis with parental permission.
- Orientation: Attend volunteer orientation (usually held monthly). Visit [www.awarewildlife.org/volunteer](http://www.awarewildlife.org/volunteer) to apply!
- Training: No experience necessary! You will be trained at your own pace based on the needs of AWARE's patients, starting with basic cleaning and feeding tasks, then gradually progress to medicating and handling wildlife.
